

GENERAL CONDITIONS

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE TRIP:

FOR EU STUDENTS: Those who are aged over 15 years old may travel with their ID or Passports, both valid for the entire stay and they will also need to bring their valid European Health Cards. Students under 15 years old should consult the special conditions of each country.

FOR NON-EU STUDENTS: They will have to go to the Spanish Consulate in their country of residence to ask for correspondence documentation they need and contract/purchase a private medical insurance. In the case of a visa is needed, the procedure will be the full responsibility of the participant.

CANCELLATIONS:

Return of the payments for the non-presence, cancellation and/or abandonment of the Interschools Plus program by the participant is not foreseen.

It is possible to contract/purchase, as an option, a cancellation insurance that guarantees the return of payments made, as long as the cause of cancellation is contemplated by the insurance company. If cancellation insurance is desired, it must be contracted/purchased at the time of contracting the program. (See Annex).

MULTI ASSISTANCE INSURANCE

Consumers who contract/join/participate in the Interschools Plus program will be able to have, if they consider, the coverage of a multi assistance insurance for student according to the conditions of the insurance policy signed with an insurance company. In this case, a copy of the coverage of the insurance policy will be sent, acting the Interschools Plus Organization as a mere intermediary between the insurance company and the consumers who have contracted/joined/participated the program. (See Annex). In case of any claim, the consumer should go directly to the insurance company. The consumer may contract/purchase other insurance. In this case, you must please inform us.

RESPONSIBILITY OF THE DIRECTORS AND COORDINATORS OF INTERSCHOOLS PLUS (hereinafter the ORGANIZATION):

The Organization of Interschools Plus declines any responsibility for what might happen to the students participating in the schooling program in Madrid if the following norms are not observed:

- They are forbidden to go out at night alone after the schedule established by the parents or by the Organization (see "Commitment");
- The use of substances that may alter the psychophysical state of the student is prohibited. Students who will be found in possession of narcotic or alcoholic substances will be expelled to their country of residence at the expense of themselves or their parents or guardians;
- It is forbidden to absent from classes without a just cause (see "Commitment");
- Any violent manifestation, both verbal and physical, will also be grounds for immediate expulsion from the program at the expense of the participant or his parents or guardians;
- The person exercising the parental authority of the student participating in the schooling program declares that the student has a good condition of health that allows

his/her participation in it, that such participation is voluntary, as well as that it is strictly voluntary and facultative and , also authorized by the parents, any action taken by the participant during his/her stay in Madrid;

- The participant must inform the Organization if he/she is subjected to any medical and /or pharmacological treatment during his/her stay in Madrid, exempting the Organization from any type of liability derived from the falseness or omission of the information. In the event that, during the development of the Program, the student needs medical treatment, and/or is hospitalized and/or surgically intervened without the Organization having been able to locate their parents, guardians or legal representatives, this is authorized to take action that it deems most appropriate for the health of the student in coordination with the Medical Center where he/she is interned. Consumers will be responsible for all invoices generated by the attentions, treatments and medical-pharmaceutical expenses that are generated as a result of health care;
- The student or the person exercising parental authority, undertakes to maintain a conduct consistent with civic obligations and not conduct behavior contrary to laws and regulations, assuming otherwise any civil or criminal liability and exonerating the Organization of the responsibility;
- The participant or his/her parents on his/her behalf, undertakes to follow and respect the instructions given by the Organization throughout his/her stay in Madrid and not to disappear from the program without prior notice;
- The participant or his/her parents in his/her name, unconditionally discharge to the Organization the responsibility, direct and indirect, for possible patrimonial and/or non-patrimonial damages and/or expenses, including legal, caused by the participant himself/herself and /or third parties;
- The Organization declines any responsibility for thefts that may be suffered by the participants during their stay in Madrid;
- The Organization declines any responsibility for damages caused by the participant derived from the disrespect to the established rules and the instructions given by it to the student;
- We advise parents that, before and during the stay in Madrid of their children, insist on the rules of behavior, with special attention to responsibility, good education and common sense. Parents must provide the Organization with an email and telephone number where they can be contacted at any time. In the event that they cannot be located, the decisions of the Organization should be considered valid.
- The participants and their parents have been informed of the general conditions of the program.
- The competent jurisdiction for eventual disputes will be in Madrid (Spain).
- For the acceptance and examination of all the information given and contained in this writing and for further acceptance of the responsibilities and exonerations of the Organization, including the exclusivity of the Jurisdiction, this document is to be signed by the participant and the person holding his/her parental authority:
